

Information on the Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act

According to the Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act (ElektroG) in force in Germany, every manufacturer is obliged to provide a reasonable opportunity for the return of waste equipment from users other than private households. Furthermore, the ElektroG contains other important requirements:

1. Separate collection of old appliances

Owners of old electrical equipment are obliged to collect and dispose of it separately. Disposal must also not be carried out via mixed municipal waste.

2. Separation of batteries and accumulators

Owners of waste electrical equipment are obliged to separate batteries and accumulators that are not enclosed in the equipment in a non-destructive manner and to dispose of them separately before handing in the waste equipment.

3 Return and disposal of old equipment

Customers of JULABO GmbH have the possibility to return devices which are subject to the EEG and have been purchased from JULABO GMBH. The return has to be registered under the following e-mail address: ruecknahme@julabo.com. After registration of the return you will receive the shipping address.

JULABO GmbH will bear the costs of treatment, recycling and recovery of JULABO products. On the contrary, JULABO GmbH asks its customers to bear the costs of return transport.

4. Personal responsibility / data protection

Any personal data on the equipment to be disposed of must be deleted by the customer in accordance with §19a ElektroG.

5. Meaning symbol crossed out garbage bin



This symbol stands for the separate collection of waste electrical equipment. They must not be disposed of in the mixed municipal waste.
